### What are cookies?

A cookie is a small file that is downloaded to your computer/smartphone/tablet when accessing certain web pages to store and retrieve information from your device. Among other functions, to store and retrieve information about browsing habits of a user in order to improve the service offered. The information collected by cookies is anonymous and does not identify the user's identity.

# Types of cookies

According to the entity that manages the domain from which cookies are sent and uses the information obtained through them, there are two types:

- Own cookies: sent to the browsing device from our own equipment or domains...
- Third party cookies: sent to the browsing device from the equipment or domain of collaborating entities..

According to the time in which cookies are stored in the user's browser, these may be:

- Session cookies: activated while the user browses the website or for carrying out a specific requested service.
- Persistent cookies: stored for a specific time in the user's browsing device. The responsible party has access to them whenever the user accesses the website.

According to the end use of the data obtained:

- Technical cookies: needed for the correct use of the website and the provision of it services.
- Customisation cookies: allow the user to access the website and the provided services with predefined general characteristics within a series of criteria at the user's device (language, type of browser...).
- Analysis cookies: allow for the tracking and statistical analysis of the behaviour of all users as a whole for the websites they are linked to.
- Advertising cookies: allow for the management of advertising space within a website, application of platform from which the requested service is provided.
- Behavioural advertising cookies: store information on the behaviour of the users obtained from the browsing habits, thus allowing to develop a specific profile in order to present advertisements.
